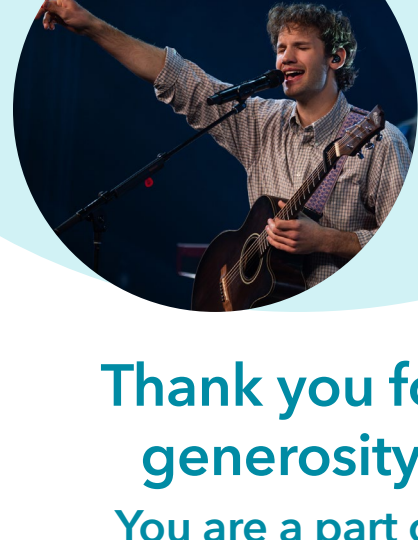

# Generosity Update

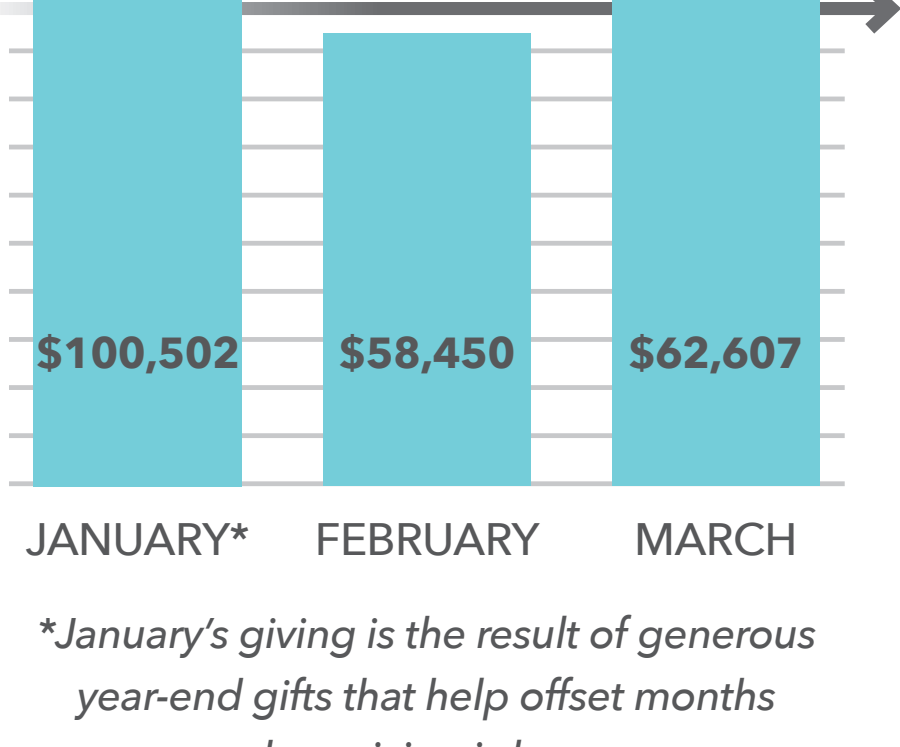


Thank you for your continued generosity to **your church!**

\*January's giving is the result of generous year-end gifts that help offset months when giving is lower.

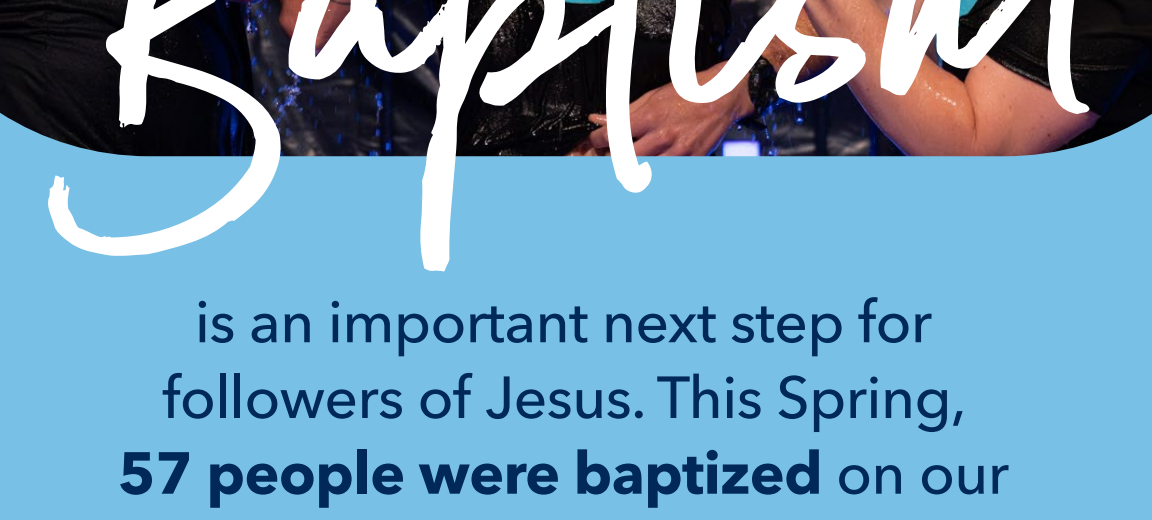
## Every[one] Building Project Update

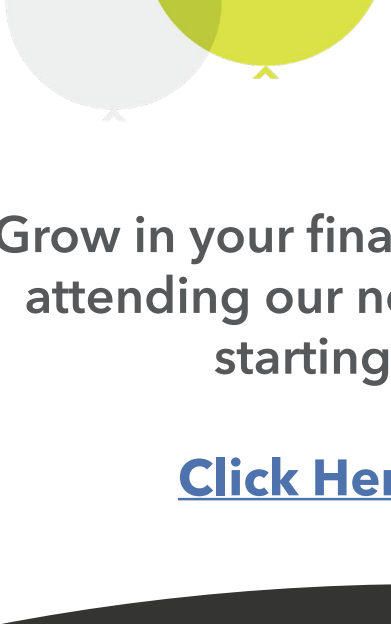
## Your Generosity Makes All the Difference
